Ordinance Reminders:

West York Borough has a curfew policy to protect our children.

Unless accompanied by a parent, anyone under the age of 18 may not be in a public place between the hours of 11:00 pm and 6:00 am. For more information on curfew specifics, please visit www.westyorkborough.org or contact Borough Office.

Skateboarding:

Skateboards and scooters may be used on the sidewalks and in the parks provided they are being used in a safe manner. However, skateboards, etc. are not permitted on private property without the permission of the owner unless it is your own property. Skateboards and scooters **are not permitted** in the streets!

A reminder about trash and recycling:

Market Street and the North Side of the Borough go out Tuesday and Friday. South of Market Street goes out Monday and Thursday. Recycling and large item pick-up is on the second pick-up day.

You are allowed 1 large item per week. If you need additional large items picked up, you may call Penn Waste directly. Holiday trash pick-up will be pushed back to the next business day. Also, as a reminder, **trash and recycling receptacles need to be removed from the curb as soon as possible and must be stored to the rear of your home.** Recycling bins are available for sale at Borough Hall for \$10 each.



Property Maintenance:

With summer upon us, just a reminder that you **can be fined for high grass** and other property related problems. Keep your neighbors happy and help keep West York looking good by taking care of your property. To report a problem please contact Codes Enforcement at 717-843-6305 and press 3.



A note about your pets:

Dogs in West York must be licensed and **must be on a leash**. Make sure your dog wears its ID tags at all times in case it gets lost. Also remember to pick up after your dog. And with the summer heat make sure your pets have plenty of fresh water.

West York now has a **Borough Animal Response Coalition (BARK)** program for lost or injured animals. Be sure to pick up a registration form in Borough Hall to register your animals in case they get lost or there is an emergency. For more information please contact Shelley Metzler at 717-846-2071.
